


Important Information regarding your scheduled condo payments for 2024




In January 2024, your condo dues are going to increase to \$410.00 per month.

Any homeowners using AppFolio for payment: if you have set up a flat amount you will need to edit your autopay and change to the new amount (\$410.00).

If you have AppFolio auto pay set up as "pay balance in full" monthly, (NOTHING is needs to be done).







If you having bill pay set up from your bank and the check is mailed to the Pfefferle Office, you will need to change your payment to \$410.00.

Between November 1 and April 1

On all other months trash containers may not be set out prior to 5:00 p.m. the day preceding collection.



Test #2

When should you replace your hot water heater?

With regular inspection, draining, and flushing, you can expect a gas water heater to last, on average, anywhere from 8-12 years.

The last thing you want is your water heater breaking down on you when you need it most (especially in the winter) so, take note of some signs that might mean trouble. These include:

Rusty water - Rumbling/gurgling - Cold water

The purpose of a hot water heater is hot water, so, if your heater is on and you're still getting cold water, it's time to call a plumber

Water/moisture

If you notice water or moisture around your hot water heater, it could mean you have a crack or a leak. Check with your plumber, it may be time to replace your water heater.

Age

Check your water heater for manufacturing date to determine the age. If you live on Tuscany Way or the east half of Sienna Way, you are probably at or past 10 years. If yours is around 10 years or older, you may want to consider investing in a new one before your current one starts to leak or cause other problems.
